SICREEE

- The Central American Integration System (SICA) is coordinating with UNIDO de preparatory phase of SICREEE, with the support of the Austrian Development Agency (ADA) and the Spanish Agency for International Cooperation (AECID).
- SICA member countries are 8: Belize, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Nicaragua and Panama.





The Central American Integration System (SICA) is the institutional framework of Regional Integration in Central America

The Central American Integration System was established on December 13, 1991, by the signing of the Protocol to the Charter of the Organization of Central American States (ODECA) or Tegucigalpa Protocol, which amended the Charter of ODECA, signed in Panama on December 12, 1962, and formally came into operation on February 1, 1993.



Purposes of SICA

- To consolidate democracy and strengthen its institutions
- To achieve a regional system of welfare and economic and social justice for the peoples of Central America.
- To attain economic union and strengthen the Central American financial system.
- To strengthen the region as an economic bloc in order to insert it successfully into the international economy.
- Promote, in a harmonious and balanced way, the sustained economic, social, cultural and political development of Member States and the region as a whole.
- Establish concerted actions directed toward the preservation of the environment through respect and harmony with nature, ensuring the balanced development and rational exploitation of natural resources of the area, with a view to establishing a New Ecological Order in the region.
- To constitute the Central American Integration System based on a legal and institutional order and mutual respect among Member States.





SICREEE Preparatory Process

- Validation Workshop was held in Costa Rica, 2017.
- Pilot of the First Operational Phase will take 2 years. Secretariat General of SICA will coordinate the pilot phase.
- Project document on the design of the SICREEE is finalized. Approved by the Council of Energy Ministers in SICA countries.





SICREEE's Objective and actions

General Objective: *“Contribute to promote in the region the implementation of RE&EE in markets, industries and innovation”.*

Result 1: Assist in the development, adoption and implementation of policies for technical coordination, implementation and harmonization at the regional level of ER & EE programs.

Result 2: Strengthening the capacity of key regional institutions and stakeholders, through research and the replica of certified training programs.

Result 3: Strengthening the collection and management of information and data, as well as the strengthening of the awareness in the use of energy carriers.

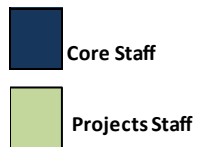
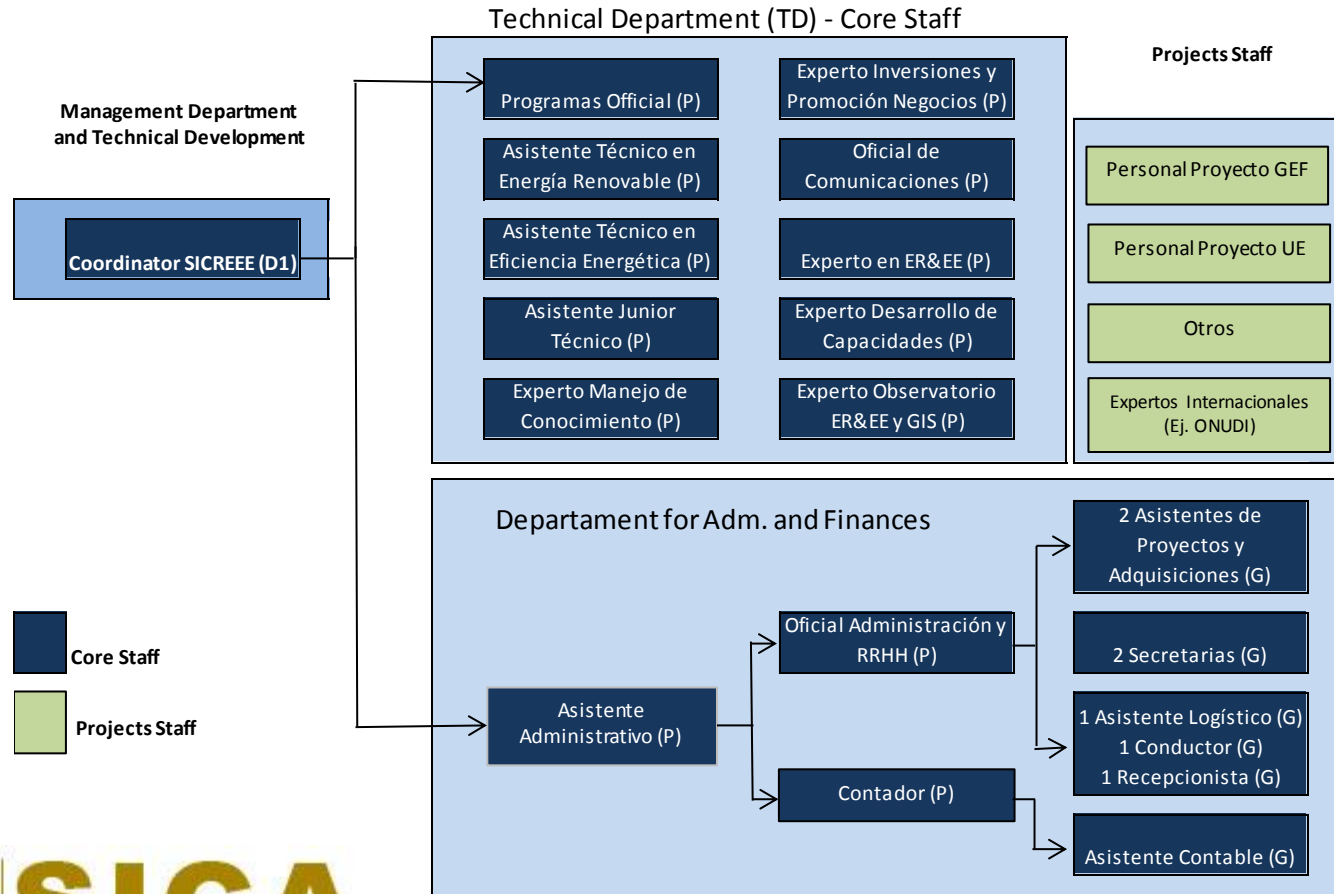
Result 4: Strengthening capacities in technological, investment and promotion of businesses through programs that promote regional investment.
